

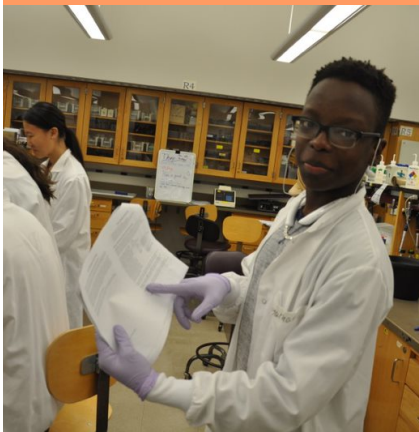

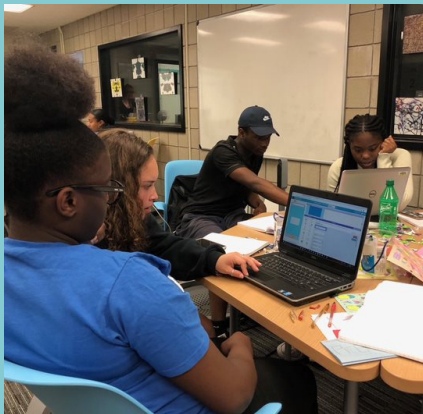
### Biomedical Research Internship: LEAH Knox Scholars
